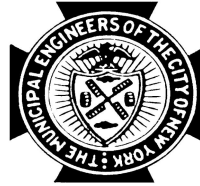

96th Street Site
Tunnel Boring Machine Launch Box***

being constructed by MTA Capital Construction Company for
MTA New York City Transit

The tour will be held on Wednesday, June 23, 2010, from 1 PM to 5 PM.

We will meet in the S3 Contractor's site office at 207 East 94th Street, 4th Floor.

This is an active heavy construction site with limited physical access. The tour may require **climbing of stairs** (80 ft worth). The site is muddy – dress for it.

Attendees are **required** to bring and wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). This includes 6 in. high work boots, hard hats, eye protection and safety vests.

Only limited amounts of PPE (and no boots) are available at the site. We regret that those who arrive without proper PPE will be unable to take the tour.

All attendees **must** show picture ID to enter the site. Non-MTA staff will be required to sign a "waiver of liability" prior to entering the site.

Due to site constraints, we are limited to 50 attendees. All attendees **must** RSVP before noon on Monday, June 21, 2010, on first-in basis, with name matching your ID to **both** david.plotkin@aecom.com and Harry.Tom@nyct.com
